

## Anna's Booties

Cast on 17 stitches.



Knit as follows: The first and all Right Side (RS) rows in purl stitch. The second row: 4 purl stitches, 1 knit stitch and 12 purl stitches. Repeat the first and second rows.



At the start of the 4<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> rows increase one stitch; this will result in 6 stitches for the sole of the boot.



After 36 rows since casting on the right side of the boot is finished.

Now continue the 6 sole stitches in purl, 1 knit stitch and for the other 12 stitches knit 3 rows and change to purl 3 rows.

Continue this way, in row 17 and 4x in the 3 purl rows, knit a shortened row for the 6 sole stitches, meaning: purl 3 and turn around with an added loop as a 4<sup>th</sup> 'stitch'. In the following row knit together the loop with the following stitch.



The front of the boot is finished after 57.



Work the left side of the boot as you did the right side, but mirror it. Cast off the last 17 stitches after 129 rows from casting on.



### **Completion**

Thread an elastic thread through the top of the purl and knit ribs.



Pick up 52 stitches out of the top of the boot.



Knit 4cm of 1 purl, 1 knit, and then cast off all stitches.



Close all seams.

Complete the other boot.



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
